Kristan has taken regular "on-air" radio shifts at KAGV 1110AM from noon to six o'clock and is enjoying the challenge of doing "live" radio without making mistakes.

She has begun the groundwork for soliciting sponsorships that will provide some of the fiscal income for KAGV. Both of these things are keeping her very busy.

Karl was able to do some maintenance work on the radio repeaters while Kristan and the pilot worked on clearing foliage and brush out of the way of the satellite signal.



Kristan also took two radio shifts at KIAM 630AM in Nenana in order to give two announcers much needed and deserved respites. During this time, Karl worked on another boiler and did some minor computer maintenance at KIAM.

As we visited these villages we are reminded of God's saving power. He can overcome any situation. Please pray that we will be up to the task of bearing good fruit in all that we say and do, and in each place that we go (John 15).

We are blessed that much has also been accomplished on the home building front.



Kristan has been working on installing drywall in the interior of the house. Our plan is to completely finish one bathroom, one guest bedroom, and the laundry room before moving in.


