This month was supposed to start with installing the radio translator in the Aleutian chain village of Perryville. However, due to a barge trip prolonged by weather, bad flying weather, and now twin-engine pilot availability, the Perryville radio translator is still not installed.

On a more praise-worthy exciting note, there was some progress made towards installing radio translators in the interior villages of Allakaket and Hughes.



We were both able to fly out and speak with Native Villagers in both areas and they are excited to have the Christian radio and some information from the "outside".

In Allakaket, located approximately 190 air miles north-

west of Fairbanks, we have been given permission to install the radio equipment at the Native Council main office.



In Hughes, here is a picture of the village church that will be home to the necessary radio equipment.

Both of these villages have reputations of being difficult. Nevertheless, God paved the way and we were welcomed into these villages and plan to install the translators by April. Please be in prayer with us that God will use the radio in these villages to bring people into a relationship with Him.

During the middle of this month, Karl climbed two towers in Nenana for KIAM 630AM in order to fix broken and install new equipment. He was able to choose a day with low winds and mere minus teen temperatures so the climb was not as uncomfortable as it could have been

although climbing 200 feet straight up into the air is more preferably done on a nice warm summer day!
